The Theatermuseum opens with the **Café im Lobkowitz** a new seasonal eatery, which offers Italian piazza street food, specialty coffees, aperitives, wine, beer and much more. It welcomes both museum visitors and external guests looking for a quiet retreat from the noise of the city as well as staff members.

The concept was devised by **Nathan Spasić**, who runs the somewhat different specialty café Goldener Papagei in Vienna's second district, and by his partner **Miki Apostolo**, who ran a three-toque restaurant before turning his back on „Etepetete“ gastronomy and now offers private cookings. Between spring and autumn, they will offer sustainably and exclusively produced drinks and snacks – freshly prepared at the bar and cooking island converted into a cargo bike set up in the beautiful baroque courtyard of Lobkowitz Palace.

The Café im Lobkowitz invites you for a relaxed stay with its light, modern and colourful furnishings. On colder days, refreshments can be enjoyed in the museum's foyer. The plants selected by floral designer **Thomas Tergowitsch** for this special place add to the special atmosphere. If you like a green plant, you can buy it and take it home, as the shop-in-shop concept envisages.

Nathan Spasić and Miki Apostolo emphasise the highest quality in their practice. When selecting their primarily local products, they consider the supply chain as a whole – which means: „We only want to offer our guests products that we can stand behind as a business. So for example: coffee sourced directly from the farmer and roasted in-house, pastries from Marischka, sourdough bread from Joseph, meat from Dormayer from Langenzersdorf, crisps from Pepi from Korneuburg, regional vegetables – if possible even from Vienna – and actually homemade lemonades,“ says Miki Apostolo.



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The Café im Lobkowitz is open **Wednesday – Sunday, 10am – 5.30pm** (except in stormy weather or driving rain); it is **accessible without a museum ticket** and it is one of only a handful of **barrier-free** eateries in central Vienna.
